



Civil Aviation Directives: 6-01 (Issue 1)

Date of issue: 19-October-2023

Subject: Exemption for aerodromes

Applicability:

The Directive shall be applicable to all aerodromes open to public use in the Sultanate of Oman.

Effective Date:

This Directive is effective from the date of issue.

Requirement and compliance timeline:

1. CAR 139 Part 1, seventh edition, Section 11.8.6 shall be as follows:

Temporary Exemptions: where the non-compliance is expected to be removed and inter-operability is the predominant aspect of the requirement, such as mandatory signs, availability of runway strip etc. Temporary exemptions are time limited and subject to review by the aerodrome operator.

2. CAR 139 Part 1, seventh edition, Section 11.9 shall be as follows:

Deviations (Permanent Exemptions): where non-compliance is not reasonably, be removed and interoperability is not the predominant aspect of the requirement, such as the infringement of high ground into an obstacle limitation surface etc.

Any deviation from a requirement and the conditions and procedures referred to in this regulation shall be set out in an endorsement on the aerodrome certificate.

3. This Directive is valid until the release of the newest edition of CAR 139 Part 1.
