

Notice to All Entities

Applicability:

This notice is applicable to All entities involved in the transport of Dangerous Goods by Air within the Sultanate of Oman.

All entities mean any Person, Air Operators, Aerodrome Operators, Ground Handling Agents, Shippers, Freight Forwarders, Cargo Agents, Training Providers and Packaging Suppliers involved in the transport of Dangerous Goods by Air within the Sultanate of Oman.

Reference:

Civil Aviation Regulation CAR 92 Dangerous Goods approved on 29th of September 2019.

Transition period:

All entities involved in Transport of dangerous Goods Shall comply with CAR 92 no later than 29th March 2020.

The Public Authority of Civil Aviation (PACA) established a new civil aviation requirement (CAR 92) related to the safe carriage of Dangerous Goods by Air to ensure compliance with ICAO standards and recommendations and improve harmonization within the industry.

The new regulation CAR 92 **SUBPART G —Certification**—require to all entities intending to accept, handle, process and involved in transport of dangerous goods within the Sultanate of Oman shall obtain the PACA Dangerous Goods **Certification** commensurate with their involvement in the Air Transportation of Dangerous Goods.

<u>From 29th March 2020</u>, No entity, other than those <u>certified</u> by the Public Authority for Civil Aviation (PACA) or as permitted by the CAR 92 shall be involved by any means in the processing and transport of Dangerous Goods by Air.

<u>From 29th March 2020,</u> OmanAir (SATS) shall not accept Dangerous Goods from any entity that does not obtain a PACA certificate.
