	- 125 hours of dual instruction. of which:		
	 75 hours visual instruction, which may include: 		
	□ 30 hours in a helicopter FFS level C/D; or		
	□ 25 hours in a helicopter FTD 2,3; or		
	□ 20 hours in a helicopter FNPT II/III; or		
	20 hours in an airplane or TMG;		
	 50 hours instrument instruction which may include: 		
	□ up to 20 hours in a helicopter FFS or FTD 2,3, or FNPT II, III; or		
	□ 10 hours in at least a helicopter FNPT I or an airplane.		
	* If the helicopter used for the flying training is of a different type from the FFS used for the visual training,		
	the maximum credit shall be limited to that allocated for the FNPT II/III;

	either a multi-engine or a single-engine helicopter and the IR skill test on an IFR-certificated multi-engine		
	helicopter.
