	<ul> <li>50 hours of cross-country flight as PIC, including a VFR cross-country flight of at least 540 km (300 NM), in the course of which full stop landings at two aerodromes different from the aerodrome of departure shall be made;</li> </ul>		
	- 5 hours flight time shall be completed at night, comprising 3 hours of dual instruction, which shall include at least 1 hour of cross-country navigation and 5 solo take-offs and 5 solo full stop landings; and		
	100 hours of instrument time comprising, at least:     20 hours as SPIC; and		
	<ul> <li>50 hours of instrument flight instruction, of which up to:</li> </ul>		
	□ 25 hours may be instrument ground time in an FNPT I; or
