Unless otherwise specified in the OSD as established for the applicable type, this take-off and landing training should include: - At least four landings in the case of MPAs (or single-pilot high performance complex airplanes (SP HPAs)) where the student pilot has more than 500 hours of MPA experience (or SPA experience) in airplanes of similar size and performance or, in all other cases, at least six landings; - At least one full-stop landing; and - One go-around with all engines operating.
