a	Applicants for the issue of an instructor certificate shall be at least 18 years of age		
b	Applicants for the issue of or holders of an instructor certificate with privileges to conduct flight instruction in an aircraft shall:		
	- For license training, hold at least the license for which flight instruction is to be given.		
	- For a rating training, hold the relevant rating for which flight instruction is to be given.		
	- Have completed at least 15 hours of flight time as pilots of the class or type of aircraft on which flight instruction is to be given, of which a maximum of 7 hours may be in an FSTD representing the class or type of aircraft, if applicable; or <input type="checkbox"/> Passed an assessment of competence for the relevant category of instructor on that class or type of aircraft; and		
	- Be entitled to act as PIC in the aircraft during such flight instruction.

a	<input type="checkbox"/> To provide training in FSTDs during an approved training course at an ATO, have completed at least 125 hours of flight time under IFR after the issuance of the IR, of which at least 65 hours shall be instrument flight time in helicopters.		
b	<input type="checkbox"/> To provide training in a helicopter, have completed at least 500 hours of flight time under IFR, of which at least 250 hours shall be instrument flight time in helicopters; and		
c	<input type="checkbox"/> To apply for an IR(H) for multi-engine helicopters, meet the requirements of point FCL.905.FI(h)(2) "Comply with points FCL.910.TRI(c)(1) and FCL.915.TRI(d)(2) in the case of multi-engine helicopters".		
	- FCL.910.TRI(c)(1). The privileges of TRIs(H) are restricted to the type of helicopter in which the assessment of competence for the issue of the TRI certificate was taken. Unless otherwise determined in the OSD, the privileges of the TRIs shall be extended to further types if TRIs have: <input type="checkbox"/> Completed the relevant parts of the technical training and flight instruction parts of the TRI course. <input type="checkbox"/> Completed within the 12 months preceding the date of application, at least 10 hours on the applicable helicopter type, of which a maximum of 5 hours may be completed in an FFS or FTD 2/3; and <input type="checkbox"/> Passed the relevant sections of the assessment of competence in accordance with point FCL.935 in order to demonstrate to an FIE or a TRE qualified in accordance with Subpart K of this Regulation their ability to instruct a pilot to the level required for the issue of a type rating, including pre-flight, post-flight and theoretical knowledge instruction.		
	- FCL.915.TRI(d)(2). For a TRI(H) certificate for single-pilot multi-engine helicopters, have completed 500 hours as pilot of helicopters, including 100 hours as PIC on single-pilot multi-engine helicopters		

4. IRI(H) Certificate Training Requirements.

a	An applicant for an instructor certificate shall have completed a course of theoretical knowledge and flight instruction at an ATO. The training course for the IRI shall include, at least:		
	- 25 hours of teaching and learning instruction		
	- 10 hours of technical training, including revision of instrument theoretical knowledge, the preparation of lesson plans and the development of classroom instructional skills.		
	- At least 10 hours of flight instruction on a helicopter, FFS, FTD 2/3 or FNPT II/III. In the case of applicants holding an FI(H) certificate, those hours are reduced to at least 5.		
	- Flight instruction shall be given by an FI		
b	Applicant for an instructor certificate shall pass an assessment of competence in the appropriate aircraft category, in the relevant class or type or in the appropriate FSTD, to demonstrate to an examiner qualified in accordance with Subpart K of CAR FCL the ability to instruct a student pilot to the level required for the issue of the relevant license, rating or certificate. This assessment shall include:		
	- The demonstration of the competencies during pre-flight, post flight and theoretical knowledge instruction;		
	- Oral theoretical examinations on the ground, pre-flight and post-flight briefings and in-flight demonstrations in the appropriate aircraft class, type or FSTD;		
	- Exercises adequate to evaluate the instructor's competencies

8. IRI Privileges and conditions.

- (a) The privileges of IRIs are to instruct for the issue, revalidation and renewal of a BIR and an IR in the appropriate aircraft category.
- (b) Specific requirements for the MPL course. To instruct for the basic phase of training on an MPL course, the IRI(A) shall:
 - (1) hold an IR for multi-engine airplanes; and
 - (2) have completed at least 1 500 hours of flight time in multi-crew operations.
 - (3) In the case of IRI already qualified to instruct on ATP(A) or CPL(A)/IR integrated courses, the requirement of (b)(2) may be replaced by the completion of the course provided for in paragraph FCL.905.FI(j)(3).
