	is provided by the CAA or which is provided by an ATO/operator and approved by the CAA.
	 The standardization course for the FE should last at least 1 day, divided into theoretical and practical training.
	- Theoretical training. Instruction on the applicable requirements in this Regulation and the applicable air operations
	requirements, the conduct of skill tests, proficiency checks and assessments of competence, and their documentation
	and reporting, a briefing on the CAA administrative procedures, requirements for protection of personal data, liability,
	accident insurance and fees and an instruction on how to get access to these national procedures and requirements
	- Practical training. The conduct of at least 2 skill tests, proficiency checks or assessments of competences for the
	licenses, ratings or certificates for which the applicant seeks the privilege to conduct tests and checks including briefing.
